- **Worksheets**  
New printable worksheets will be available in Appraise-It Pro. These worksheets provide designated spaces for entering data and align with the new dynamic form, making field data collection possible without using a device.
- **Checklists**  
A simple two-page checklist allows appraisers to mark off completed items. While there is no space for data entry, it serves as a reliable way to ensure all required information is collected for each report.
- **Digital**  
A new dynamic report will be available in Appraise-It Pro for use on any Windows tablet or laptop. This report is designed specifically for the subject property and can be taken into the field. Once back in the office, no re-entry is required—the data seamlessly converts into the full UAD 3.6 appraisal report.

Although mobile appraising has been promoted as a requirement for UAD 3.6, it is not mandatory. While mobile workflows may simplify the process, these upcoming non-mobile options provide effective alternatives.

#### SOLOMON ADJUSTMENT CALCULATOR

We now have an integration with the [Solomon Adjustment Calculator](#) built into Appraise-It Pro. Appraise-It Pro users who are also Solomon subscribers can now go to **Services > Solomon Adjustment Calculator** to launch and log into the Solomon web tool. Use the options in the sidebar to transfer report data back to Appraise-It Pro without having to retype it.
